DRESS CODE FOR GRADUATES

Modest dress, proper etiquette, and Christian behavior are required for the Prayer Service, Graduation Dinner and Commencement.

<u>MAY CROWNING - Thursday, May 17, 2018 - Due to the religious nature of this event, modest attire is requested.</u>

Boys: Wear dress shirt with tie, dress pants, <u>dark</u> socks and dark dress shoes. No tennis or athletic shoes. No bow ties.

Girls: Wear dresses appropriate for church, no mini skirts, no short dresses, no low cut, form-fitting, strapless, bare back, or spaghetti straps. A good rule of thumb is no more than three inches above the back of the knee for all dresses. Preferably low-heeled dress shoes, no espadrilles.

<u>Dresses must be tried on and approved by Mrs. Danowitz.</u> <u>Dress approval dates are April 20, April 27 and May 9.</u>

PRAYER SERVICE AND DINNER - Wednesday, June 6, 2018

Boys: Wear dress shirt with tie, dress pants, <u>dark</u> socks and dark dress shoes. No tennis or athletic shoes. No bow ties. Dress jacket or sweater is optional.

Girls: Wear modest dress, no mini skirts, no short dresses, no low cut, form-fitting, strapless, bare back, or spaghetti straps. Preferably low-heeled dress shoes, no espadrilles.

Natural (very light!) looking make-up may be worn. <u>Rule of thumb: If the make-up is noticeable, there is too much</u>. Small earrings may be worn – no dangling earrings. French tip or pale pink polish on nails will be allowed.

<u>Dresses must be tried on and approved by Mrs. Danowitz.</u> <u>Dress approval dates are April 20, April 27 and May 9.</u>

FAREWELL MASS - Friday, June 8, 2018 - No caps, GOWNS only

Boys: Wear a **WHITE** long sleeved dress shirt with tie and dark dress pants, and **GOWN** only. <u>Dark</u> socks and dress shoes only. No tennis or athletic shoes. Now bow ties.

Girls: Dressy dress, and low-heeled dress shoes, no espadrilles (can be the same dress and shoes for Graduation Day or Prayer Service).

<u>Dresses must be tried on and approved by Mrs. Danowitz. Dress approval dates are April 20, April 27 and May 9.</u>

COMMENCEMENT EXERCISES - Friday, June 8, 2018 - Caps and pressed gowns

Boys: Wear a **WHITE** long sleeved dress shirt with tie and dark dress pants, cap and gown. **<u>Dark</u>** socks and dress shoes only. No tennis or athletic shoes. No bow ties.

Girls: Wear modest dress, no mini skirts, no short dresses, no low cut, form-fitting, strapless, bare back, or spaghetti straps. Preferably low-heeled dress shoes, no espadrilles.

Natural (very light!) looking make-up may be worn. <u>Rule of thumb: If the make-up is noticeable, there is too much</u>. Small earrings may be worn – no dangling earrings. French tip or pale pink polish on nails will be allowed.

<u>Dresses must be tried on and approved by Mrs. Danowitz. Dress approval dates are April 20, April 27 and May 9.</u>
